

USATF Masters T&F Report – Records

As of this date, 127 record applications have been processed in 2018.

National Indoor Championships 28 (Relays 8, Non-Relays 20)
National Indoor Combined Event Championships 1
Other Indoor Meets 13 (Relays 1, Non-Relays 12)
National Outdoor Championships 23 (Relays 8, Non-Relays 15)
National Outdoor Combined Event Championships 2
World Outdoor Championships 11 (Relays 5, Non-Relays 6)
National Throws Championships 5
Other Outdoor Meets 44 (Relays 7, Non-Relays 37)

Some of the applications received recently are still under review. The current status of each current & past application is still available at www.usatfmasters.org, and will be permanently stored online.

Steps were taken this year prior to both the Indoor and Outdoor National meets to provide current records for the meet management software (Hytek). Major benefits resulting from these steps:

- 1) The announcer, media, administrators, spectators and officials can recognize record-breaking performances sooner;
- 2) Up-to-date records will enable officials to identify and process record-breaking performances at the meet (and also help avoid wasting time processing performances that, in the past, were thought to be records, but in fact were not.)

2018 Budget: \$3000

Reimbursed: \$1320.43 to work at the Outdoor National meet in Spokane.

Not reimbursed: \$1435.66 to attend the 2017 USATF Annual Meeting

2019 Outlook

This budget will continue to cover attendance at the 2019 Indoor & Outdoor National Championship meets.
