Thank you for another track and field season supporting the Masters Historical Task Force and related website: <http://mastershistory.org/>

During 2020 significant improvements included: Additional scanning of over 1,000 pages (into searchable PDF format), and many web-pages were added, updated and improved.

The Rex Harvey Collection, David Pain Collection, Al Sheahen Collection, Randy Sturgeon Collection, and Peter Mundle Collection pages were added and updated. Additional research allowed to add web-pages for the Masters Mile M40 Record Progression, History of Masters Track and Field 1968 to 1971, list of all the USA Track & Field Convention locations from 1888 to 2020, and links from 2006 to 2020 (except 2008) USATF Competition Rules. Additional updates included: links to Masters Bios increased, past World and American records information increased, links to additional meet results, and list of Associations and Regions were updated. The Hall of Fame and the Awards pages were updated. Depth of meet results of the 1968 to 1970 Masters National Outdoor T&F Championships were increased. The committee also updated / improved several Masters T&F related Wikipedia pages.

The committee also continues to make our services available to support other USATF efforts.
