Masters Men's (Age 50) 400 World Record Falls @ US Indoor Championships:

The Men's 400 Invitational Race was very exciting. The oldest man in the race, **Khalid Mulazim** (age 50) representing the Southwest Sprinters Track Club, led the race until the final 45 meters, when he got past by the overall winner, **Gabriel Fuzat** (age 42) also of Southwest Sprinters Track Club, and Pearland, TX, who won the race in 51.58. **Khalid finishing second overall, broke the Men's 400 Meter World Record of 52.38, with a time of 52.02. Brian Duff** (age 40) representing Track Club L.A., was third right on Mulazim's heals in a time of 52.37. **Jason Rhodes** (age 44) representing So Cal Track Club. and from Actadenia, CA, ran 53.37, and **David Cahill** (age 40), representing Greater Boston Track Club., and Newton, MA, finished in 54.24.

In the Masters Women's 1000 Invitational Race, Sonja Friend-Uhl, age 45, representing Atlanta Track Club, dominated the race leading wire to wire in 2:56.65. The race for second place was very competitive with Lisa Valle, age 50, New Mexico Track Club, and Albuquerque, NM, out-kicking, Terry Ballou, age 49, Athena Track Club, and Conway, New Hampshire, in 3:14.17, and 3:16.04, respectively. Followed by Laura Mitchell, age 40, Team Rogue, 3:18.05, and Anna Mayhew-Rozek, age 41, 3:27.31.
